To be admitted to the role of godparent, a person MUST

- Be (16) years of age
- Be a practicing Catholic who has received the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation (*certificate attached- YES / NO*)
- If married, marriage must have been in the Catholic Church (*certificate attached- YES / NO*)
- Lead a life in harmony with the Catholic faith and the role to be undertaken (Canon 874))
- A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community may not be admitted *except as a witness to baptism together with a Catholic sponsor.*"
